Ensure you're sitting pretty with the best re-editions and new must-haves

- 1 For Giorgetti's 10th birthday, the iconic 'Move' rocking chair, first created by Rossella Pugliatti back in 2014, takes on a fresh personality in three new colourways. Approx £25,625 (giorgettimeda.com).
- 4 Handmade to order in the UK, 'La Chair' sits at the intersection between furniture and sculpture. Plus, there's an eco-leather version available on request. From £3,200 (rankineditions.com).
- **7** The 'D.154.2' armchair by Gio Ponti recently received the Compasso d'Oro Career Award. This marks it as a gold standard in design, so Molteni & C's gold edition is appropriate. £9,360 [molteni.it].
- 2 Brazilian modernism is set to have a big year (see p.52) and the 'Brasilia' by Anderssen & Voll combines it with a mid-century Scandinavian sensibility. Approx £3,760 (audocph.com).
- 5 The angular lines of 'Perceptions' part of a nine-piece collection by this up-and-coming New York-based studio – are softened by its plump seat. Approx £6,340 (knownworkstudio.com).
- 8 As if G&O Buratti's original 'Calin' armchair wasn't plush enough, the design has been updated, making it bigger and more comfortable. The ultimate cocoon for lounging. From £6,842 (porada.it).
- 3 The backrest, seat, armrest and sides of Martino Gamper's 'Figura' can be mixed and matched in a tantalising selection of different shapes and Rubelli fabrics. From approx £2,800 (rubelli.com).
- 6 Like its companion sofa, Carl Hansen & Søn's 'Sideways' chair by Rikke Frost is intriguing from all angles, with its steam-bent timber back strung with natural papercord. From £3,284 (aram.co.uk).
- 9 This limited-edition version of the 'Archibald' armchair by Jean-Marie Massaud sees it dressed in a suit made from an organic-cotton jacquard called 'Everdenim', Approx £4,390 (poltronafrau.com).
